Six-Month Episode



Cancer Episode Triggered

Episode begins with an initiating cancer therapy:

- Part B chemo claim w/ cancer dx or
- Fill date of Part D chemo claim with corresponding part B claim w/ cancer dx on day of or in 59 days preceding



Episode Attributed to EOM Participant

Attribution :

- To PGP providing the first qualifying E&M service after the initiating chemotherapy, provided that the PGP has at least 25% of the cancer-related E&M services during the episode



Total Cost of Care Management & Option to Bill Monthly Enhanced Oncology Payments (MEOS)

Total Cost of Care:

- Medicare Part A & B for all care settings
- Certain Part D Payments (low-income subsidy)

MEOS Payments:

- Billed monthly, up to six total:
- \$70 for non-dual patients
 - Add'l \$30 for dual patients (\$100 total)

Mechanism to fund practice transformation



Performance-based Payment (PBP) or Recoupment (PBR)

PBP or PBR:

- Retrospective reconciliation each PP
- Based on total expenditures compared to episode target price with quality and GAF adjustments
- Stop-gain or stop-loss based on Risk Track selected by PGP
- PGPs may elect to “pool” performance with other PGPs or share savings/risk with “Care Partners”
